This position is responsible for operating the remote-controlled sewer camera on our sewer locating crews. Must be able to work independently and be a self-starter, be mechanically inclined, and have the ability to work with a form of technology such as IBAK Sewer Camera Equipment. This position will require operating remote cameras to videotape inside sewer lines for inspections and determine if cleaning and/or repairs and reinstatement of service laterals after rehabilitation (cutting taps) are needed. This position will be supervised by the Sewer Camera System Technician II in assisting as needed on the repairs and maintenance of sewer main.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Tests and inspects sewer line breaks, infiltration and flow
- Locates and inspects manholes.
- Cleans sewer lines
- Perform any other duties as required.

WORK EXPERIENCE - KNOWLEDGE REQUIRED FOR THIS POSITION:

- Experienced workers with a background in sewer camera operations are highly desired.
- To be considered, applicant should have a clean driving record and be able to pass a background screen.
- Ability to work in confined spaces.
- Must be able to travel frequently and frequent walking.
- Physical strength and endurance to perform manual labor for extended periods of time, possible under adverse weather or working conditions.
- Ability to carry 50 pounds or more.
- Must be available to work weekends and holidays.
- Ability to respond to emergency call-outs after normal working hours.
