

CURBSIDE COLLECTION GUIDANCE

Bulk Item Pick-up:

The collection and removal from curbside of bulk items including but not limited to refrigerators, washers, dryers, dish washers, ovens, hot water heaters, carpet and furniture shall be made in accordance with prescribed policies established by the handling department and as manpower and equipment allow. The fair and reasonable rate for this service is \$10.00 per item.

Building debris:

Any building debris such as plaster, roofing, concrete, brickbats and other such rubbish resulting from repairs, remodeling or construction of any building or private property will not be removed by the city. The owner of the premises or the contractor, professional landscaper, builder or the person doing the repairs, remodeling or construction shall haul away and dispose of all such debris, including stumps, trees and limbs, at his expense

Tree service permit; disposal of cuttings:

- (a) All holders of a tree service license or any person engaging in the cutting of trees for hire or compensation shall first be required to obtain a permit from the building official giving the location and date of the cutting proposed to be done.
- (b) This section shall apply to all debris which exceeds the definition of refuse acceptable for collection by the city.
- (c) It shall be unlawful for any person to trim or remove trees within the city unless the byproduct from those services is immediately removed from the premises and placed or deposited by the person trimming or removing such trees in a disposal site.

Collection of leaves, grass clippings and similar materials:

- (a) Residential refuse such as leaves, grass clippings, straw, small yard and garden clippings and other similar materials may be placed at curbside for weekly pick up or as city equipment and manpower are available.
